



SDA Board Position: President Elect

Commitments:

1. in the absence of the President, perform the duties of the President;
2. succeed to the office of the President;
3. prepare for and attend board meetings and AGM
4. sit on committees of the board as required
5. sit on the Finance/Audit Committee and is a signing authority (ie. banking, CRA)
6. involvement in external activities (ie. training, U of S graduation)
7. perform such other duties as may be assigned by the board and the president.

Term: one year, elected by membership

What type of activities does the president elect perform?

The president-elect is learning the role of President and preparing to take over this role. As such, the President Elect works very closely with the President and in the absence of the President will perform the duties of the President. To best prepare for the role of the President, the President Elect will become involved in the same committees that the President is involved with including the Finance/Audit Committee.

Estimated number of hours: 50 hours/year

A minimum of 8 meetings per year with the SDA Board and committee meetings as required to fulfill their mandate.
