

**SDA Board Position:** Public Representative

**Term:** Two years, appointed by Government of Saskatchewan (Ministry of Health)

## **Commitments:**

- Prepare for and attend Board meetings
- Sit on SDA committees of the Board and the Discipline Committee
- Attend SDA AGM
- Make decisions in the best interests of the public
- Develop a good understanding of the profession and all of SDA documents
- Represent and comply with Board decisions
- Conduct oneself in a professional manner

What type of activities does a public representative perform? Attend board meetings regularly and serve on committees of the board. The following committees require at least one public representative: Discipline, Finance/Audit, Governance.

Estimated number of hours: 50 hours/year

A minimum of 8 meetings per year with the SDA Board and committee meetings as required to fulfill their mandate.
