

Bylaws of the Saskatchewan Dietitians Association

Title

1. These bylaws may be cited as *The SDA Fees Bylaws, 2021*.

File Application fee

2. The non-refundable fee payable for opening an application to become a licensed dietitian in Saskatchewan is \$105.

Initial registration and licensing for practising members

3. The fee for initial registration as a member and for the relevant licence to practice in the initial registration year is:
 - a. \$330, in the case of a person who applies for initial registration on or before September 30 in a year;
 - b. \$165, in the case of a person who applies for initial registration on or after October 1 in a year.

Renewal of annual practising licences

4. The annual fee payable for renewal of any annual practising licence is \$330.
5. All annual renewal fees are payable on or before March 31.
6. A person who fails to pay the required licence renewal fees by March 31 ceases to be a licensed practising member as of that date.
7. A person who fails to pay the required licence renewal fee prior to March 31 may subsequently apply for renewal of their practising licence on payment of:
 - a. the licence renewal fee described in section 4; and
 - b. a reinstatement fee of \$50.

Temporary licences

8. Subject to subsection (2), the fee for a temporary practising licence is \$27.50 per month.
9. There is no fee for a temporary practising licence to provide follow-up care to professional services provided in another jurisdiction in Canada or to provide dietetic services not available in Saskatchewan.

Other fees

10. The following fees apply as indicated:
 - a. Canadian Dietetic Registration Examination fee is equal to the amount charged by the Alliance of Canadian Dietetic Regulatory Bodies to SDA;
 - b. assessment fee to evaluate substantial equivalence is equal to the amount charged by the third-party agency to SDA;
 - c. Records administration fee (eg. Licence reprint, verification of registration) is \$25.

Refunds

11. The Registrar shall refund one-half the annual licence fee in the case of a member who resigns prior to October 1 in any year.

Coming into force

In accordance with subsection 13(2) of the Act, these Bylaws come into force when they are made by the board.
