Temporary licensure with SCD can be issued for a minimum of one month, up to three months (extendable at the discretion of the Registrar) with the condition that the dietitian remains fully licensed in another Canadian dietetic regulatory body and participates in their continuing competence/quality assurance program. If you are eligible for and requesting temp licensure, please indicate the length of time you are requesting temporary licensure. Cost is \$27.50 per month but will be waived if you meet the criteria set out in the registration policies (ie. short term follow up for services received out of province or for services not available in province).

Full licensure with SCA is \$330 per licensing year (April 1-March 31) or \$165 for half year (Oct. 1-March 31) and must participate in the SCD continuing competence program.
