

# **Saskatchewan College of Dietitians Fee Bylaws**

### **Title**

**1** These bylaws may be cited as *The SCD Fees Bylaws, 2024*.

### **Application fee**

**2** The non-refundable application fee is:

- (a) \$105 for applicants who have completed their dietetic education at an approved program; and
- (b) \$400 for applicants who require a substantial equivalence assessment to determine registration eligibility.

### **Initial registration and licensing**

**3** The fee for registration and the relevant licence to practice in the initial registration year is:

- (a) \$370, in the case of a person who applies for initial registration on or before September 30 in a year;
- (b) \$185, in the case of a person who applies for initial registration on or after October 1 in a year.

### **Renewal of licences**

**4(1)** The annual fee payable for renewal of any annual practising licence is \$370.

(2) All annual renewal fees are payable on or before March 31.

(3) A person who fails to pay the required licence renewal fee prior to March 31 may subsequently apply for renewal of their practising licence on payment of:

- (a) the licence renewal fee described in section 4; and
- (b) a relicensing fee of \$50.

**Temporary licences**

**5(1)** Subject to subsection (2), the fee for a temporary practising licence is \$30.85 per month.

(2) There is no fee for a temporary practising licence to provide follow-up care to professional services provided in another jurisdiction in Canada or to provide dietetic services not available in Saskatchewan.

**Other fees**

**6** The following fees apply as indicated:

(a) the Canadian Dietetic Registration Examination fee is equal to the amount charged by the Alliance of Canadian Dietetic Regulatory Bodies to the college;

(b) the assessment fee to evaluate substantial equivalence is equal to the amount charged by the third-party agency to the college;

(c) records administration fee (eg. licence reprint, verification of registration) is \$25.

**Refunds**

**7** The registrar shall refund one-half the annual licence fee in the case of a registrant who resigns prior to October 1 in any year.

**Repeal**

**8** All former fee bylaws are repealed.

**Coming into force**

**9** In accordance with subsection 13(2) of the Act, these Bylaws come into force when they are made by the board.
